## Eastern Region of the Scenic Rim

### 1. Thunderbird Park Caravan & Camping

Nestled amongst the subtropical rainforest of Tamborine Mountain, Thunderbird Park offers glamping tents and powered or unpowered spacious caravan and camping sites, along with two amenity blocks, communal camp kitchen, fire pits, and an onsite kiosk, restaurant, and a variety of adventure activities including Tree Top Challenge & Dig IT. ### 2. Canungra Showgrounds & Camping

The comfy, shady Canungra Showgrounds sits close to a running creek with a fantastic swimming hole, perfect for cooling off summer campers. Powered or unpowered creek-front sites are within easy reach of amenities blocks with hot showers, an undercover BBQ area, and a coin-operated laundry. Pets are welcome. ### 3. Sharp Park River Bend Bush Camping

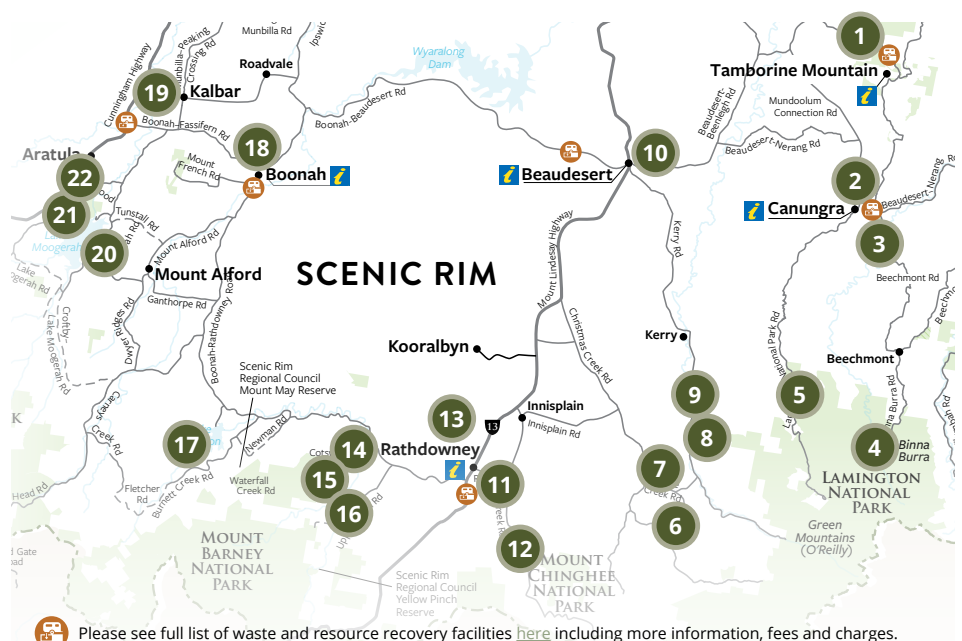
